Firstly, Apologies for the late response. I have answered you point bypoint.

- 1. Three things:
 - 1. I have a record of trying to generate funding from income £2million in the last budget.
 - 2. Second, I will be trying to get all Council services involved in finding and prioritising ways of delivering service that BOTH protect jobs and maintain services while reducing costs.
 - 3. I will campaign to end the Council tax freeze and raise tax only in the circumstances to protect services. (due to the economic climate)
- 2. Yes
- 3. I have demonstrated at the last budget a willingness to increase budget priorities on social care specifically for the elderly. In the future, I will continue to increase the general proportion where possible and again look at service user, worker generated solutions to protect services.
- 4. The level of payments are a matter of national resources and local allocation. I would seek benchmark levels and agreement that purchasing power is the the reference point for spending by the LA and continue to lobby for more resources.
- 5. Yes, I will propose a living wage motion in the new Council.
- 6. I have moved opposition to the classroom assistant cuts. I have demonstrated how the reversal of those cuts could be paid for.
- 7. I will do three things.
 - 1. Lobby national politicians
 - 2. Campaign across Parties for social justice and benefits reform.
 - 3. Help and nurture, social and community enterprise in supporting vulnerable and building community self help.
- 8. No. Social wages and salaries should relate to the job done and increase in line with general wealth.
